Exploring Cybersecurity

Cybersecurity is the practice of defending computers, servers, mobile devices, electronic systems, networks, and data from malicious attacks. It's also known as information technology security or electronic information security. The term applies in a variety of contexts, from business to mobile computing, and can be divided into a few common categories.

Anyone can accidentally introduce a virus to an otherwise secure system by failing to follow good security practices. Teaching users to delete suspicious email attachments, not plug in unidentified USB drives, and various other important lessons is vital for the security of any organization.

Melissa will review ways and best practices to help Fairs protect their on-line systems, some of which would be on-line ticket sales, credit card transactions, computer networks and security systems.

Two fairs took ideas from that workshop and combined some other ideas into a very successful programs for their fairs, one of which realized increased sponsor revenue of over 300% for the Fair.
